OLD BUSINESS

- Area 3: discussed ability to communicate with SE Iowa Chapters that were previously dissolved and absorbed into Area 3; ISRT Board was asked to review Area dissolutions and utilization of ISRT CEU compliance. Don Bishop to inquire with the ASRT in regards to the ISRT's CEU compliance obligations to other Areas in Iowa as well.
- 2. Vendor for Website: Tracy Kimler and Joni Caplan have been investigating and researching multiple new options for vendors for our new ISRT website upgrade. AngelFire, Word Press and Square Space were the main 3 presented. Multiple demonstrations were presented by Tracy, showing the many options available from each vendor. Costs and other options, including security questions regarding Hawkeye Static access, with the sites were weighed and discussed as well. Tammy Delker motioned to get Word Press, unanimously approved. It was requested that areas email photos in JPEG form to Tracy Kimler for our new website

NEW BUSINESS

- Storage totes contents: Connie Spicher discussed with the Board some of the contents of a few boxes that she had brought in from the Storage Unit, discussing what to keep and what to dispose of. Legislative Report

I met with Angela Leek – Bureau Chief from the Iowa Department of Public Health – Radiologic Health Section on May 23rd, 2016 to go over any State and Regulatory Updates. The following are the highlights of our meeting:

- The state has been receiving many calls about the CT /Nuc Med CT technologists certification process and if the state will be placing CT back on their permits to practice, training etc. Currently, the state is not making any changes to their current process.
- The state is still moving forward with it's on-line registration process for its permit holders and the radiation emitting equipment licenses. The software go-live is planned for August with permit holders using the system in October 2016. Facilities getting their equipment licensed with the state will have questions they have to answer about certain processes IE radiation protection/safety, badges what you are doing at your facility etc.

- NO bill made it thru the legislative process here in Iowa Breast density was discussed multiple times but nothing moved forward. Next chance will not be until Jan 2017. Other proposed bills have to do with Radon, Tanning Beds, Hand Held Dental equipment and talking about wearing lead glasses and having dosimetry badges for those hand held devices.
- There is a bill in Congress effecting MQSA, the state will be waiting for congress to make it's changes prior to changing anything here in the state of Iowa.
- Still having conversations about CRNA's supervising 19luoroscopy they still have to meet the requirements and the nursing board qualifications as well.
- ARIBEX (Nomed) has a piece of medical equipment that is for extremities hand held and Limited to 60 KV. Discussions are taking place about this type of hand held mobile device and meeting practice standards.
- Once the on-line system is up the state will be moving forward with the radiation equipment chapters. They will be bringing in stake holders but the chapters will be broken down so they are easier to find and interpret. Examples of Chapters may be: Radiology, Dental, Podiatry, Flouroscopy.
- There is NO longer is there a 30 grace period (if there ever was one) on your license/permit to practice. If the holder is expired the state will be contacting the facility to find out if that employee has worked. With the new on-line system the READY TO ISSUE message equals ACTIVE. Permits will be emailed to everybody and no longer printed, they will have a QR code instead of a raised seal. Facilities will be able to pull all information needed immediately.

I will be on a conference call June 7th with the ASRT Region 5 Advocacy Committee to review legislative happenings as well. Tracy Kimler, Matt Millard and Terri Whyle will also be on the call. Tracy is the team lead for the Region 5 CRTA Advocacy Committee.

I will be attending the ASRT annual meeting in Las Vegas at a state delegate. Tracy is moving to the Radiology Chapter delegate, so Iowa will have 3 board members at the state meeting.

My next meeting with the IDPH will be August 25th, 2016.

Once again there was great attendance. The speakers again this year made a great impact on the students. The student exhibits were outstanding and represented many aspects of radiation and imaging.

- I will soon be distributing the Educator list and asking for updates and will present the new listing to the ISRT web editor.

New Guide lines for the ARRT exam have been posted. One question was brought up about the ARRT geriatric requirement.

An educator spoke with the ARRT and asked if there was a specific age and was told no. The patient just has to show that they are physically or cognitively

impaired as a result of aging. The individual that she spoke with said that the patient could be 55 years of age and show these results of aging .Unfortunately it is VERY broad.

The first HOD Business meeting was called to order by Mike Odgren-ASRT Speaker of the House. The opening ceremony was started off by the presentation of the Flags which were carried by the 97 Students attending the leadership academy, all active affiliates were represented. This was followed by the singing of the National Anthem and the Pledge of Allegiance. There were 158 seated delegates present at the meeting. ASRT UPDATE- was given by Sal Martino, CEO of the ASRT. Sal just signed anther contract with the ASRT for 3 more years. The ASRT has 153,000 members, 116 staff with a 24 million operating budget. Sal went over a variety of things that the ASRT does for its members but he wanted everyone to know the ASRT is not just about CEU's. The ASRT awarded 49 grants valued at \$68,500. We have an International Exchange program and a community outreach fellowship for RT(R) and Therapy. The ASRT will be celebrating 100 years in 2020 and the annual meeting will be back in Alburque, New Mexico for the event.

AFFILIATE OPEN FORUMS- Nevada, Missouri and North Dakota all spoke. Missouri and North Dakota on licensure and Nevada on how to get students and other technologists involved. "Why wouldn't they join the state society" was a motivational topic at one of their meetings.

ARRT REPORT was given by Gary Gustafson. Effective January 2017, all violations must be reported within 30 days. Board certifications will no longer count as CEU's. CQR recipients will receive letters/notifications 3 years prior, they do not have to re-take a test. It's a structured self-assessment. ARRT is moving away from its annual seals and will soon be electronic.

JRCERT REPORT was given by Stephanie Eatmon. There are 609 Radiology programs, 73 Radiation Therapy programs, 10 MRI programs and 19 Medical Dosimetry programs. There were 135 site visits for accreditation in 2015.

No late motions were presented. Steering committee, Election of Speaker of the House and Vice Speaker of the House took place. The meeting was adjourned at 11:23 AM in record time. 
