HISTORIAN REPORT

WEBMASTER / HAWKEYE STATIC EDITOR REPORT

Tracy presented the Hawkeye Static report.

Advertisement size and pricing was discussed. Neapolitan changed the ad size on the website during the design phase. The size is 400x400 pixels. The current advertising application states 300x300 pixels. A vote would be expected to update the application for the new pixel size. The current cost for a 1 year ad is \$360. A vote would be expected to update

the application if the price would change to accommodate the new pixel size.

PARLIAMENTARIAN AND BYLAWS REPORT

Rosie reported that no new names of deceased technologists have been received. She also presented the bylaws update. Rosie also reported that the ISRT Fellows applicant has met all criteria. Tracy Kimler will be elevated to ISRT Fellow at the 2018 Annual Meeting & Education Symposium.

OLD BUSINESS

Neapolitan Labs update from Brian McMillin.

The Neapolitan version of the isrt.org website launched Dec 21, 2017. 1100 page views. Recommends:

1. Using social media to get more traffic on the site and adding more events to the tab.
2. Pay for membership online, updates with wording as well.
3. \$10.00 minimum donation payment for scholarships and also the ability to choose your own price.
4. Payments take you to PayPal. Standard shipping for coin is \$1.50.
5. Need to add MJ Keilly fund to scholarship options.
6. Spell out active membership to ASRT or ARRT memberships required for membership to ISRT, Option for auto-renewal on membership could be added.
7. Proposal to have Neapolitan Labs maintain the website. Dedicated email for our site with guaranteed three day turn around with marked priority items updated sooner. Quarterly updates. \$3,000 dollars a year for pricing.

Dissolution update by Don: Will be resubmitted again after the corrections and proper signatures have been made.

Board of Director and Appointed position roles: Discussion of the roles on the board and expectations, with training ahead of time. Timeline of things to be done throughout the year, and new board positions for April. Terri Whyte proposed to have elected board members to have a 2 year term.

WEBMASTER/ HAWKEYE STATIC EDITOR REPORT

SwankHealthcare has been purchased by Relias Learning. Our new contract was signed by Joni Caplan as the Exec Secretary of our organization. She has provided me with the membership list that will be migrated into Relias Learning program. The SwankHealthcare site will go down end-of-day February 1, 2018. Migration will take place transferring all usernames, profiles and completed courses. On February 8th, I will have administrator training and go-live should be February 9th. All users will need to reset their unique passwords. All members will receive a bulk e-mail explaining the need to reset their password.

The ISRT website has transitioned to the Neapolitan design and control. On 11/18/17 the website transitioned from ISRT control to Neapolitan. The original go-live projected date was the week of Dec 8.

On Dec 21st, the website was available for the public to view information only.

I brought it to Brian’s attention that if the ad size was to be changed, it would need to be approved by the Board at a meeting and the application changed. *Currently the sponsor application states the size of Dimensions 166 x 333 pixels for \$360/year. *Neapolitan put ads on the website as 400 x 400 pixels *Neapolitan also changed the sponsor approved ad

size and look without me getting approval from the sponsors. Their company's advertising departments made the ad look according to their practices. We cannot change it without approval. The University of Iowa Bachelor of Science ad needs to be changed back instead of the generic black/white sketch of a college building. (I directed Neapolitan to change the ad photo and size back to original. They have not complied.) Please add to New Business a vote on Sponsor Ad size and fee associated for the change in size (if any). If the size or fees change I'll notify the sponsors and have the Executive Committee approve the change in the application.
