PROPSED CHANGES TO CURRENT ARTICLE

SECTION 3: TERM

A. The First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary and such additional officers as are recommended by the Board of Directors and ratified by the membership shall serve for a term of one (1) year or until their successors have been appointed or elected and assumed office. The Secretary may be elected for a two-year term upon recommendation of the Board of Directors and ratification by a majority vote of the voting membership.

B. The President-Elect shall serve for a term of one year as President-Elect, one year as President, one (1) year as immediate Past President and one year as senior Past President.

C. Terms of office shall begin at the conclusion of the Annual Meeting at which an officer is installed (whether or not actually present for the installation).

RATIONALE

Responsibilities and obligations allocated to the officers are at the peak of understanding at the end of their current term, therefore a two-year term in each elected office is beneficial to the Society.
