GRT BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING November 7th, 2020

The November meeting of the ISRT Board of Directors was held on November 7th, 2020 at MercyOne Comfort Center for Women, Education Room, Suite 151--Clive, Iowa and via Zoom. The meeting was called to order by President Terri Whyle at 9am.

The following members were present:

Introductions were made. A quorum was established.

MINUTES

Minutes from the June ISRT BOD meeting have previously been distributed. No changes were made. Motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Budget was previously approved via email. Darrin provided a breakdown for the year end finances for FY ending 9/30/2020. Motion was made and seconded to approve the year end financing. Motion carried. Darrin presented the new budget for FY beginning 10/1/2020. It was noted that the budget was based on an in-person spring symposium which will likely change. Motion was made and seconded to approve. Motion was carried.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Tammy submitted a proposal to increase pay for the CEU management position from \$100 to \$400 due to increased time necessary to accommodate the increased workload in management of this. Motion was made and seconded to approve increase. Motion Carried.

ISRT activities were proposed for NRTW 2020 to be advertised on social media. Monday followers would be asked to submit a picture/video of their organization's activities. Deadline for submission is Friday, gift cards awarded to the three most liked submissions. Additional proposed activities were trivia, free CEU, and the president's message. Activities requiring financing include the free CEU, a \$50 gift card and two \$25 gift cards. Motions were made and seconded to approve funding for these items. Motion carried.

PUBLIC RELATIONS

Lindsey reported that the 2020 Proclamation for National Radiologic Technology Week was signed without an in-person ceremony due to COVID and was mailed directly to her residence. Additionally, she is updating the Facebook and Instagram accounts with the new ISRT officers.

Yvonne reported that the website is up and running. The member portal is still experiencing some updating in respect to membership renewal and allowing members to immediately pick or update their password. She kindly requested that BOD pictures are submitted for the website.

LEGISLATIVE ADVISORY REPORT

Matt provided information regarding the IDPH report changes. Specifically, the new regulations on gonadal shielding and ARRT changes to CE requirements starting in 2022. Regarding shielding, registrants are required to continue to adhere to the current rule of shielding until the IDPH makes a rule change. Organizations may file for a variance and must wait for approval.

HAWKEYE STATIC EDITOR

Matt reports that the current issue of Hawkeye Static is published on the website. Deadline for submissions for the December issue are November 15, 2020. He is currently in need of the approved June and September meeting minutes and the proposed 2020-2021 budget.

CONTINUING EDUCATION MANAGER

Yvonne Grant submitted her report. Proposed ideas to changes in CEU offerings included the possibility of a corporate rate for a comprehensive CEU package, a 2-year CEU discounted rate for members of \$60 and for non-members of \$65, and investigation of a discounted Relias rate since we are nowhere near the 800 capacity mark. These items to be addressed again in January. It was noted that a disclaimer may be necessary reminding those utilizing the CEU's that per IDPH & ASRT guidelines, one may not ever duplicate a self -guided learning CEU.

EDUCATION REPORT

Stephanie provided the report. Jean reported that the student year requirement in the scholarship application is not applicable to programs like the University of Iowa as a three-year program. It was also noted that for some, the scholarship is now awarded when they graduate but can be used to pay back loans. This is likely due to the change from fall to spring.

PARLIMENTARIAN REPORT

Hannah reported that the memorial names were being held onto since they have yet to be recognized at a meeting.

BYLAW REPORT

Hannah reported that she was ready to send the bylaw changes to the ASRT parliamentarian, confirmed contact information.

ASRT Meeting / Delegates:

New Business

EXECUTIVE SECERETARY REPORT

The executive secretary report was submitted by Darin Delker and distributed for review to the BOD via email. No questions were brough forward regarding the report. Darin reports that many membership renewals have come in since the beginning of January helping the finances. A motion was made by Christina to approve the financial statement, the motion was seconded by Lindsey, motion was carried.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

The executive committee report was submitted by Tammy Delker and distributed for review to the BOD via email. No questions were brought forward.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT

The membership report was submitted by Christina Yeager and distributed for review to the BOD via email. No questions were brought forward. Christina reported that the numbers are currently low, but improvements have been seen throughout January. Corrections are being made to the website regard-ing membership renewal. Matt is going to advertise the CEUs free with membership during today's free CEU presentations.

PUBLIC RELATIONS

The membership report was submitted by Lindsey Guiterrez and distributed for review to the BOD via email. No questions were brought forward. It was noted that no nominations are required for the 2021-2022 year due to the changes made to two-year office terms.

HAWKEYE STATIC EDITOR

Matt Millard reports that the due date for submissions for the March issue of the Hawkeye Static is February 15, 2021. Currently he still needs the President's Letter, the membership list, and any other articles you think would be good inclusions.

ONLINE EDUCATOR REPORT

The membership report was submitted by Yvonne Grant and distributed for review to the BOD via email. No questions were brought forward. Matt noted that he would remind students at the student educator meeting that their first year of membership to ISRT is free once they have passed boards and submit their ARRT member number.

EDUCATION REPORT

Stephanie Setter provided the report and Terri included the scholarship forms. Stephanie reports that she has received some completed scholarship forms and is inquiring how to submit them. Terri advised to scan the forms and email them to Terri and Matt or to send them USPS attention to Terri.

Stephanie inquired about the forum for the meeting regarding virtual or in person. Terri stated that the meeting will be 100% virtual. Matt states that he needs a moderator for the educator forum.

PARLIMENTARIAN & BYLAWS REPORT

Hannah reports that she has received no death notifications since taking over the parliamentarian office. Terri reported that no official notices are made and that they are received by word of mouth. It was suggested that we do a social media and website push for notices so that we can honor them at the meeting and pass on to the ASRT for memorial at their annual meeting in June. Notifications can be directed to Hannah via email.

Hannah also reported that she is still waiting on Jason Bradley regarding the biennial report and its ability to double as articles of incorporation. ASRT questioned Hannah as to whether we had secured legal representation to review these items for us. Darin reports that the incorporation articles should be a one-time submission and only the biennial report needs updating. Yvonne reports that the ASRT must approve the changes to the bi-laws and need to post by mid-February; Hannah will continue to reach out to Jason Bradley until she gets an answer.

LEGISLATIVE ADVISORY REPORT

Matt provided updated information regarding the IDPH report changes looking at an effective date of July 21, 2021. Matt estimates that changes will open for public comment in March 2021 and we should look to the website and email for notice of rule change. The changes appear to be mostly terminology and the statement that gonadal shielding should no longer occur. Reminder that current rules must be followed until changes are effective unless a variance has been filed and approved. Noted that bystander and occupational shielding requirements have not been removed in these changes.

Connie Spicher states nothing new to report.

The MRI group thanked the ISRT for holding the contest and awarding the money and reported that the prize money was used to purchase 8 bed pillows and 4 large boxes of laundry detergent for the St. Joseph's Family Shelter. This shelter is the only in their area which welcomes in entire families facing homelessness to keep them together. Terri will email out the thank you letter and picture the department sent to the members of the board.
- Terri spotlighted that the November/December 2020 issue of the ASRT Scanner contains interview quotes with Dixie Ferguson who completed the online advocacy class.

- Don reminded the group that there are two lowans involved in the ASRT Board elections and to remember to vote.
- Yvonne reports to the group that the Oregon RT society reached out stating that they like our social media presence and website and wanted to know if they could have access to them to use as a model in building their own. Yvonne asked the group if they could have access for 2 weeks to investigate, no concerns were expressed by the Board.
